Lame Delegation Control

Current Procedures

- Accept delegation only on correct configured servers
- Check (at least)
 - correct delegations weekly
 - Lame delegations every 2 days
- Report at Whois
- Report to contacts twice a month for lame delegations lasting more than a week



Lame Delegation Control

“Lame” definition

- Executes a non-recursive SOA query at delegated servers.
 - NON AUTH-answers
 - Unknown domain name
 - Unknown host
 - ServFail
 - Query/Connection Refused
 - NOT SOA
 - CNAME
 - SOA Version
- On multi-zone delegations a single delegated server for one of the zones makes it as lame as the type of the prevailing error.
